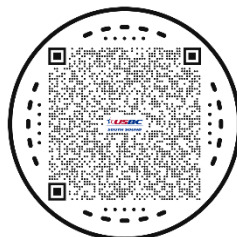

Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is open to all USBC Youth bowlers. USBC membership cards must be presented at check-in. Entrants will use highest **current** USBC certified league average based on a minimum of 12 games as of Jan 22, 2024.
2. Entering Average: Entrants will use averages in the following order:
 - a. A bowler having both a Sport or Challenge and a Standard average we will use the higher of the two without conversion.
 - b. Current average as of Jan 22, 2024 with 12 games or more.
 - c. Highest USBC 2022/2023 average of 12 games or more.
 - d. In the event a bowler only has a challenge or sport league average, the average must be converted using the USBC Challenge or Sport conversion chart found on BOWL.com.
 - e. USBC Rule 319a(2) – 10-pin rule does not apply
 - f. Failure to report an accurate average will result in disqualification.
3. This event will be a **SCRATCH** competition in four average divisions, each division will be combined boys and girls. Tournament Management reserves the right to combine Divisions when entries warrant. (In such an event refunds will be offered to anyone who does not want to bowl in a combined division.)
4. Entry fee will be \$50.00 per entry: \$30 lineage/expenses & \$20.00 prize fund. Prize fund will be paid out 100% in plaques and scholarships (administered by the SMART program – Acct. #9009).
5. You must submit your average verification as of Jan 22, 2024 with entry. Entries will be considered up to 30 minutes before start time on Feb 11, 2024 if spots are available.
6. The qualifying round will be held on **Sunday, Feb 11, 2024**. Each bowler will bowl four (4) games of qualifying to determine the finalists in each division. The top five (5) finishers in each division will then advance to the stepladder championship round to be held 30 minutes after the qualifying round. In this round the 5th qualifier will bowl the 4th qualifier, and then the winner bowls against the 3rd qualifier, winner bowls against 2nd qualifier, and then the winner bowls the top qualifier for the Classic Masters Division Championship.
7. **First place winners will receive their awards at the SSUSBC Annual Awards Banquet.** Plaques will be given to the winners. All other awards will be presented within 30 days of tournament completion. Perpetual trophy will be displayed at the bowling center of the highest placing SSUSBC bowler. Awards will be presented on at least 1:5 ratio in all divisions with prize fund returned 100%. Any added scholarship money will be pro-rated per division.
8. **DRESS CODE:** Dress attire must be neat, clean, and proper fitting. Khaki/Dress pants or shorts fingertip length of any color. Black jeans only with no distress marks. Skorts/Skirts that are fingertip length or longer and must have shorts underneath. Collared shirts and/or recognized bowling shirt styles. Spandex leggings, exercise wear, basketball shorts, blue jeans, short shirts, that show midsection will not be permitted. Youth participants shall not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting racial, political, alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures or offensive subject matter. No electronics will be allowed in the settee area to include, phones, earbuds, or head phones. Hats will not be allowed, unless with a doctor's note. Violators will be subject to disqualification and entry fee forfeiture. Tournament Manager and Volunteers will monitor dress code during all tournaments.
9. USBC Rule # 303B will apply: Tournament management has supervisory control of all technical parts of the operation of the tournament. The decision of tournament management shall be final except where an appeal is made to USBC Headquarters.
